

ENGLISH REQUIREMENT - EU & INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

For entry onto postgraduate programmes, the minimum IELTS level accepted by Middlesex University is 6.5 or a TOEFL grade of 575 (paper based test) or 237 (computer based test). We do not accept any other qualifications as proof of English competence for entry into postgraduate programmes.

The British Council hosts an International Language Testing Service (IELTS) in their offices around the world. You will find the nearest office to you and their contact details by visiting the website www.britishcouncil.org Alternatively; you can perform the test here in Middlesex University. PRE-SESSIONAL ENGLISH

Middlesex University offers Intensive Academic English courses which are designed to help you with the English Language and study skills that you need for the degree programme you have chosen. The Intensive Academic English courses last 5-17 weeks and are for both undergraduate and postgraduate students. They have both Summer and Autumn entrypoints for IELTS level 4.5 up to level 6.0.
